कितने लोग इस तथ्य से शायद ही अवगत होंगे कि दिल्ली मेडिकल एसोसिएशन की बिल्डिंग में पंजाब नेशनल बैंक और यूनाइटेड इंश्योरेंस कंपनी के किराये से केवल बिजली पानी और स्टाफ़ की सेलरी का खर्च ही निकल पाता है और मेम्बरशिप वेल्फ़ेयर के सभी कामों के लिए हमारे पास कोई

निश्चित फंड या धनराशि नहीं होती !

पिछले साल २०२२-२३ की हमारी टीम (डा अवतार कृष्ण और डा अमरजीत पोपली) ने कड़े प्रयासों से तीस लाख से ज़्यादा की बचत कर नया रिकॉर्ड क़ायम किया और इस वर्ष भी हम लगभग पंद्रह लाख रुपये से ज़्यादा एसोसिएशन के खाते में जोड़ पायेंगे

पिछले दिनों ट्रेड लाइसेंस की आइ में साउथ दिल्ली के सेंटर को म्यूनिसिपल कॉर्पोरेशन के अधिकारियों द्वारा सील किया, इस पर बहुत ही लो प्रोफ़ाइल एप्रोच की ज़रूरत है ! सम्बन्धित अधिकारियों को इस समस्या से अवगत कराया गया है, मेरा सभी मित्रों से अनुरोध है कि वहाटसेप ग्रुप पर आंदोलन करने की बजाय विनम्रतापूर्वक अधिकारियों को डील करें क्योंकि आलरेडी फ़ायर इश्यू पर एक मेम्बर द्वारा ली गई आक्रामक एप्रोच का खामियाज़ा सबको भुगतना पड़ रहा है !

Simultaneously, a role for private enterprises can be carved out, particularly in areas where innovation and competition can enhance service quality and efficiency.

The dialogue must extend beyond ideology to practicality. Striking a balance that ensures healthcare accessibility for all while leveraging the strengths of private enterprise demands a nuanced and collaborative approach. An effective hybrid model could potentially combine the compassion of public service with the efficiency and innovation of the private sector.

Ultimately, the question of whether healthcare should be a state matter or a corporate affair is not an either-or proposition. It's a call for a thoughtful integration of both, ensuring that the healthcare system functions as a cohesive and compassionate entity, prioritizing the health and well-being of all citizens.

Dr. R.V. Asokan for assuming the role of National President of the
Indian Medical Association (IMA) Headquarters**



One of the most able leader the Association has ever produced, Dr Asokan is known more for his generosity, kindness and humility. Indeed great virtues which inspires each one of us to emulate. Yet he is better known for his heart than for his might.

He began as a grass root worker. Coming from Tamil Nadu and settling in Kerala obviously would have posed even more challenges. He emerged slowly and steadily from the shadows of Punalur a small town in Kerala where he set up his practice , creatively engaging in professional and association activities

In late eighties when he was heading the College of General Practitioners in Kerala. Later he went on to become the State Secretary and then State President of IMA in early 2000. He bravely led struggles for the profession historic Secretariat March, he led as President, when thousands of Drs from all over the state thronged the capital demanding peace in hospitals.

If Dr Asokan is going to be remembered for just one thing, it's undoubtedly going to be IMAGE, the bio medical waste management scheme of IMA. The visionary in Dr Asokan created this unique model for scientific treatment of all biomedical waste, almost two decades back, which till date is the only such facility in Kerala and is the pioneer model in the country too. He had to pledge his own hospital to manage finance for the mission which has now grown as the flagship project of IMA.

He got involved in control of Tuberculosis globally and became the only Indian to be the editor of the WHO technical advisory. He brought in numerous projects for control of Tuberculosis in the nation and represented the country in many world bodies including WHO and UN.

Hospital Board of India is yet another contribution of Dr Asokan, which he still heads. HBI not only began addressing the issues faced by small and medium institutions but also gave them a huge leap by enabling NABH accreditation, hither to the domain of huge hospitals.

He's undoubtedly the master brain behind most of the agitations the Association undertook for Professional rights. Faced with any issue, be it violence, CE bill, NMC or Ayushman Bharath, the Association keenly look towards him to workout solutions and he surely did.

He has only India in his mind, the only song which he loudly sings being the National Anthem. A man with no ego he's so approachable to anyone and always sports a pleasing smile. A voracious reader, Dr Asokan relishes books on politics, history and philosophy which he's happy to share, albeit takers are few. His love for animals too is unparalleled. He rears two pugs, but his home is also house for many stray dogs who are fed and looked after equally well.

He's now leading the organisation as National President of IMA, a responsibility which is long overdue. Campaign to increase GDP in healthcare, provision for universal health care, safety of health care workers, reducing burden of criminal prosecution will be some of the focus points for the coming year.

DMA RULES & REGULATIONS

ELECTION OF PRESIDENT ELECT AND TWO VICE PRESIDENTS

❖ **Election Commission**

The State Executive Committee shall appoint Election Commission comprising of Seven members, one of which shall act as Chairman of the commission and Hony. Secretary as the convenor. Anybody who is contesting shall not be the part of the Commission. The Chairman, Election Commission shall on or before 10th January each year call the nomination through DMA News Bulletin from the valid members as on 31st December of Previous year.

- For the post of President Elect
- Two Vice Presidents

❖ **Criteria for the Candidature :**

❖ **President elect and Vice Presidents**

- Minimum 5 years of continuous membership of the association either direct or through a local branch or through both.
- Must enroll himself as life member of IMA.
- Any member seeking election to the above mentioned elective posts of DMA should have been either a member of the State Executive for 3 years or should have held any post of DMA as Office bearers for at least one year.
- A candidate who polls less than 5% of total votes polled shall not be eligible to contest for any of the above for next 3 years.

❖ **Code of Conduct**

- One cloth Banner measuring 3 meter outside DMA Building or venue of Zone on the adjacent road is allowed to each candidate. The banner shall be outside the Polling area decided by the Chairman of the election.
- Press advertisement, Press release & Press conference for election purpose shall be banned Electronic Canvassing is permissible.
- Communication to the voters by the candidate or candidates is allowed through DMA News Bulletin on payment of maximum of two pages in one issue, duly approved by Election Commission. No other communication is permissible.
- Any contravention or violation of electoral Rules & Bye Laws will be taken as election dispute and dealt accordingly. If the contravention or violation is proved the defaulter will be disqualified for four years including the year of election in which violation has been committed.

The nominations in sealed envelope must reach the office of the Election Commission i.e. DMA by 3.00 pm on **24th** January every year. Nomination paper shall bear the endorsement from the Branch Secretary verifying that the candidates, proposer and seconder have paid their membership subscription upto 31st December. In case, the endorsement of payment has not been made by the branch Secretary, the nomination paper shall stand valid only if DMA records, confirm that the signatories have paid dues upto 31st December. Nomination shall be accepted only on nomination paper/s issued by DMA office.

The nominations shall be opened in the meeting of State Executive on **24th** January every year. The valid nominations will be communicated to Presidents/Secretaries of all branches by post (Speed Post) and would also be displayed on DMA Notice Board.

The last date of withdrawal will be upto 3:00 p.m., **28th** January every year. Withdrawal must be submitted in sealed envelopes, which shall be opened in the Executive Committee on the same day. Withdrawal papers once submitted cannot be withdrawn. After the withdrawals only, the name of the valid candidate will be circulated through DMA News Bulletin. They will also be communicated to all concerned by Speed Post / Email.

The voting shall be held in five zones of Delhi on Sunday 9.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. after having given a clear time of 10 days for canvassing but not later than 15th Feb every year. The local branches shall vote as follows in various zones.

- Central Zone** : **Central Delhi Branch, LHSP Branch, Direct Members, Karol Bagh Branch**
- East Zone** : **East Delhi Branch**
- South Zone** : **South Delhi Branch, New Delhi Branch**
- West Zone** : **Westtown Branch, Janakpuri Branch, Dwarka Branch, Outerwest Branch**
- North Zone** : **Delhi North Zone Branch and Rohini Branch**

Venue of election for each zone shall be decided by DMA executive. One member of Election-commission shall be responsible for the conduct of election in each zone with the help of professional team.

No member of DMA except for the member of election commission shall have any role in conduct of election.

Member of election commission appointed to a particular zone will not be a member of either of the branches voting at the centre.

Each candidate shall be entitled to send one representative to each centre as an observer.

No voter without a photo identity proof shall be allowed to cast his/her vote.

After the polling, member election commission of that zonal centre shall seal the ballot boxes in presence of the Observers of all the candidates. The details of number of ballots issued at that centre shall be provided to the observers at the centre itself.

The sealed ballot boxes shall be taken to DMA House for counting to be undertaken on same day. All the arrangements for the election shall be made by DMA. Local branches shall have no role in conduct of election.

No other election can be tied up with DMA elections.

The executive committee of any local branch through a resolution can request DMA to cast its vote at any of the zonal centres.

❖ Election Process

- The valid voter list available with phone nos & emails should be provided to the contestants for better/electronic communication to voters.
- The election for the above post shall be held with use of most modern technology aimed at increasing the participation of maximum members and ensuring the fairness of procedures. Therefore a valid voter list with available phone nos. & E-mail should be provided to the contestants for better/electronic communication to voters.

❖ POLLING BOOTH VOTING BY SECRET BALLOT OR ELECTRONIC VOTING MACHINE

- The election shall be held by Electronic Voting Machine / secret ballot (at the time of polling) issued to all members on the rolls of association on whose behalf H.F.C. has been deposited by 31st December as life member. The valid list will also include the annual members on whose behalf H.F.C. has been deposited by 30th June. The valid list shall also be displayed on the notice board of DMA and same will be sent to the branch Secretaries by 10th January of every year.
- Ballot papers shall bear the seal of the association and signature of any two members of the Election Commission for this purpose. No envelope shall be necessary for the Ballot Paper.
- Ballot papers will be delivered to the Chairman, Election Commission at least 48 hours before the Polling date.
- The ballot paper shall be issued by the polling Officer to the valid members against the signature after establishing the identity through one of the means- Photo identity card issued by Voter ID Card, issued by Delhi Govt., Driving License, Ration Card valid one if it carries your photograph, Pass Port, Aadhar Card. Photo Identity Card issued by any recognized statutory authority (e.g. PAN, Post Office, Police etc.) to cast the vote.

Each member shall be issued separate ballot paper each year for post of President elect and two Vice- Presidents.

- The ballot box shall be sealed in presence of President/Vice President, one of the Secretaries, Presiding Officer/Election Commission and Candidates or his observer for the election.
- The Ballot Box shall be kept in the custody of the Presiding Officer during the Polling time and shall be kept in the office under the key which shall remain with Chairman, Election Commission.
- After total polling is over, the counting shall take place immediately. The Chairman, Election commission and his team shall hand over the sealed ballot box to the team of Scrutinizers (3-5) appointed by the Election Commission.
- The Chairman shall open the ballot box before the Scrutinizers and the candidates or their Observer nominated by them, and hand over the ballots to the Scrutinizers. The Ballot papers would be counted and if any discrepancy between ballots issued and recovered from the box is found, it shall be recorded and signed by the Chairman and the Scrutinizers.
- The Scrutinizers will count the votes before the candidates or their observers nominated by them, criteria for invalidating a vote would be mentioned on the ballot paper and the same shall act as guidelines for the Scrutinizers.
- The ballot papers shall be sorted out separately for the President elect, Vice Presidents counted accordingly.
- For each category the scrutinizers shall record the votes polled in the names printed on the ballot papers.
- These results shall be signed by all the scrutinizers and submitted to the President, who shall place these results before the State Executive Committee within 2 days of receiving it. Among the Vice Presidents, candidate polling maximum votes shall be the Senior Vice President. For any post candidate/s securing votes in order of merit shall be decided depending upon the number of seats vacant.
- The result shall be displayed on the Notice Board and published in DMA News Bulletin and communicated to all elected candidates and branches by post (Speed Post).

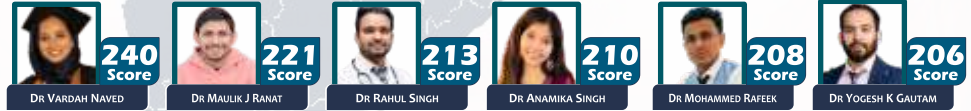
