To mark this occasion, **DMA will celebrate Doctors' Week from 28th June to 5th July 2026**. I encourage all branches to organize health check-up camps for doctors, blood donation drives, wellness programmes, and recreational activities. The celebrations will culminate in the **DMA Doctors' Day Conference on 5th July 2026 at Hotel Le Meridien, New Delhi**.
